3 **ANTARCTIC ICE REMOVAL PROGRAM**  
4 **SHAREHOLDERS TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT**  
5 **AND TESTING LOCATIONS**

7 **PURPOSE**

8

9 1. Eugenix P.S.A. To accommodate shareholders needs to properly develop and test all necessary  
10 technology to remove their share of ice form the Antarctic has decided with Arcticus Blancus to  
11 designate for each Eugenix P.S.A. shareholder a part of Greenland on the western and eastern shore of  
12 size according to shareholders shares lot for the purpose of development and testing of their Ice Removal  
13 Systems in conditions less extreme than those of the Antarctic that will allow to save human lives and  
14 develop such technology much faster and much closer to shareholders home states. All shareholders are  
15 permitted to test and develop Ice Removal and transport technology in the Antarctic at the same time in  
16 the patch of Ice removal areas.

18 **TESTING AREAS DIVISIONS**

19

20 2. Shareholders as mentioned in the first paragraph are allowed to test their technology in parts of  
21 Greenland. Eugenix P.S.A. to allow shareholders adequate area to conduct successful technology  
22 development process followed by testing has dedicated areas of a following size based on number of  
23 shares. Greenland western shore will be allocated for shareholders of states located in America, Asia,  
24 Pacific Ocean, Australia. Greenland eastern shore will be allocated for shareholders of states located in  
25 the rest of the world mainly, Africa, Middle East, India, Southern Europe.\

27 **TESTING AREAS LOT SIZES**



29 3. Each shareholder is allowed to lease from Eugenix P.S.A. and Arcticus Blancus an area equal to  
30 15 km<sup>2</sup> for each share assigned to the shareholders state that has been allotted to shareholders based on  
31 the size of the population in states of shareholders. Greenland Western Testing Shore is composed of

32 600,000 km<sup>2</sup> from 62.75 N to 77.75 N. Greenland Eastern Testing Shore is composed of 900,000 km<sup>2</sup>  
33 from 62.75 N to 77.75 N. The minimum width of the shoreline allotted to shareholders will be 5 km, the  
34 allotted territory will extend inland. Shareholders will have the right to lease west instead of east and vice  
35 versa upon availability and approval of Eugenix P.S.A. The land above 77.75 N. is reserved for the  
36 Geomagnetic Dams Construction.

## SHAREHOLDERS HABITATION

41

42 4. Shareholders and all their research and development teams are not allowed to habituate areas  
43 outside to areas allotted to shareholders for research and development activities associated with antarctic  
44 ice removal program. All non-indigenous resident and nationals of Greenland currently occupying  
45 Greenland will be relocated to Alaska and Scandinavia as described in the eugenix eugenix® indigenous  
46 territory - permanent protection areas. Current capitol of Greenland Nuuk will be converted into a  
47 Eugenix P.S.A. Administrative city for and shareholders activities related to development and testing of  
48 ice removal technology that will be used in Greenland by all shareholders.

## DECOMMISSION BONDS

51

52 5. All shareholders prior setting any temporary and permanent infrastructure on shores and inland of  
53 Greenland will have to submit data related to planned infrastructure and equipment for eugenix P.S.A. to  
54 calculate for shareholders decommission bond's that shareholders will have to deposit to eugenix P.S.A.  
55 to cover all calculated financial expenses associated with shareholders abandonment of development of  
56 ice removal technology that will result in expenses to Eugenix P.S.A. to remove all left by shareholders  
57 temporary and permanent installations.

## ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

61       6.      Eugenix P.S.A. will not allow shareholders to ship to Greenland and develop in Greenland any  
62 technology that uses regular painted steel metal. All ships, boats, vehicles, technology, temporary and  
63 permanent infrastructure of any kind must be of paint free non-corrosive food-grade or better type of  
64 stainless steel. All used by shareholders' research and development teams' petroleum and other non-  
65 biodegradable chemicals will also have to be brought in and stored in stainless steel barrels and  
66 individual stainless steel cargo containers designed for such chemicals.


## ANTARCTIC TESTS - TUGBOATS AND TUGGING

69

70 7. All testing related to Ice block hauling using nuclear or greener power for push and pull tug  
71 vessels should be done in the Antarctic – on the Weddell Sea path of the Ice Removal Program full of  
72 dislodged from the Ronne Ice Shelf large ice blocks. Testing of the tugging vessels and Ice Removal

73 technology can also be done in the Antarctic opposite direction and in the shareholders leased area of the  
74 Greenland shore. A short summary of ice transport logistics is outlined in the publication titled Eugenix®  
75 Shareholders Ice Removal Tugging Research and Development. Shareholders development and testing  
76 activities in the Antarctic region will require Eugenix P.S.A. approval and Decommissions Bonds.
