11	PETITION TO THE EU PARLIAMENT FOR THE UPC BASED
12	RECYKLING DATABASE

14	Summary of the petition
15	
16	This petition requests that the European Parliament mandate a public, searchable UPC-based database
17	linking every product sold with a registered UPC to detailed recycling, warranty and material-origin
18	information. The database must require the company that registers the UPC to provide: the producer(s) of
19	man-made materials used in packaging for consumables; a complete list of materials for non-consumable
20	products including sub-supplier information; and return addresses for warranty service, whole-product
21	recycling, and recycling destinations for each listed material-component. The UPC database web address
22	and a QR code (where space permits) must be printed below the UPC barcode on product packaging.

24	Requested legislative actions
25	
26	1. Require mandatory registration of every product UPC in a centralized EU database with publicly
27	accessible records.

29	2. Require the UPC registrant to provide and keep updated the following data for each UPC record:

31	a. Producer identification for packaging materials in consumable products;



33		b. Complete list of materials and components for non-consumable products including
34		supplier chains for materials originating from other producers;

36		c. Return address for warranty service;

38		d. Return address for whole-product recycling;

40		e. Return address for recycling of each material-component listed.

42	3.	Require the UPC record to include an official database URL and a machine-readable QR code
43		reference; oblige manufacturers or packagers to print the database URL or QR code under the UPC
44		barcode where packaging space allows.

46		Establish enforcement mechanisms including fines, market access restrictions, and compliance
47		audits for registrants who fail to provide or maintain accurate supplier and material data.
