19	I ASK THAT THE EUROPEAN UNION PARLIAMENT SET LAWS FOR ALL ALCOHOL
20	AND NONALCOHOL GLASS BEVERAGE COINTAINER BOTTLES TO BE PRODUCED
21	FOR THE PURPOSE OF RETURN TO PRODUCER-REFILLER PREVENTING ANY AND
22	ALL GLASS BEVERAGE COINTAINER BOTTLES FROM EARLY DISPOSAL THAT
23	CAUSES IRREVERSABLE IMPACT TO THE CLIMATE AND NATURAL RESOURCE
24	ENERGY. I ASK THATALL GLASS BEVERAGE COINTAINERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF

54	LASTLY I ASK THAT ALL RETAIL AND WHOLESALE PLACES CHARGING THE
55	DEPOSIT FOR THE COINTAINERS AND THE TRANSPORTERS HAVE RIGHT TO
56	DEDUCT 10% OF THE DEPOSIT FROM THE RETURNED COINTAINERS BUT NOT
57	THE TRANSPORTERS FOR THE COST OF ACCEPTING THE RETURNABLE
58	COINTAINERS BUT ONLY ONCE IN THE PROCESS OF RETURN OF THE
59	COINTAINERS TO THE RETAILER OR WHOLESALERS THAT HANDELS THE LOW
60	VOLUME-COST TRANSACTION OF COINTAINER RETURN UNLESS THE UNLESS
61	ALCOHOL REFILLERS-PRODUCERS COVER THAT COST FOR THE RETAILER-
62	WHOLESALERS. 10% FEE SHOULD BE ALSO A PAYMENT TO COVEER ANY STORE
63	AREA THAT IS TAKEN BY THE TRANSPORTERS AND ANY FUTURE BOTTLE
64	COLLECTING AUTOMATION AND ANY COSTS TO THE EMPLOYERS PAYING THE
65	SALARIES OF THE EMPLYEES ACCEPTING THE COINTAINERS AND
66	TRANSPORTERS. FEE DEDUCTED FROM THE DEPOSITS SHOULD NOT BE MORE
67	THAN 15% OF THE VALUE OF THE RETURNED REFILLABLE COINTAINER.
