## ARCTICUS BLANCUS INDIGENOUS RESERVATIONS ADMITTANCE GUIDELINES

### INTRODUCTION

The admittance rules contained in this guide will only cover the admittance rules and priorities for the Arcticus Blancus indigenous persons to the Arcticus Blancus indigenous reservations. The admittance rules to the reservations for the non-indigenous Arcticus Blancus persons affected by various outdigenous medical and genetic conditions such as albinism, skin cancer will not be covered in this admittance guide due to lack of indigenous relations between such persons and Arcticus Blancus indigenous polar persons and due to a lack of formal United Nation resolution that covers the rights for persons with outdigenous conditions to seek more suitable habitation. Eugenix P.S.A. as a company dedicated to the geomagnetic climate repair as proposed in the *Eugenix® United Nations - Antarctic Treaty - Annex Petition* and dedicated to the restoration of the indigenous rights around the world as proposed in the *Eugenix® United Nations - Convention for Genocide Prevention and Punishment - Annex Proposition* has plans to develop suitable solutions for outdigenous persons affected by various medical conditions and genetic disorders that require Arcticus Blancus temporary territorial assistance.

### ARCTICUS BLANCUS

Arcticus Blancus and are based on the Arcticus Blancus prolonged inhabitation of unique to Arcticus Blancus polar territory that physically and genetically acclimatized and symbiosed only Arcticus Blancus indigenous polar persons to such polar territory making the Arcticus Blancus company Eugenix P.S.A. right to claim polar region just a formality that must be done. Indigenous symbiosis between the



32 Arcticus Blancus indigenous polar persons and their polar climate is a result of development of physical  
33 characteristics that adapted Arcticus Blancus indigenous persons to polar climate that also resulted in  
34 Arcticus Blancus lose its physical adaptation to sub-polar climate.

35

36 The evidence of such polar adaptation and non-polar inadaptation as present in many polar  
37 species such as *Ursus Maritimus* is the presence of the white-translucent and clear-transparent hair in the  
38 Arcticus Blancus and other polar species that naturally unique only to the polar climate regions that  
39 adapted Arcticus Blancus and other polar species bodies to absorb smallest amounts of light radiation  
40 present for up to six months of the year that with the help of light absorbent white hair pigment and light  
41 transportive clear hair shafts Arcticus Blancus and other polar species bodies are able to absorb and  
42 regulate the amount light in own subcutaneous tissue.

43

44 Arcticus Blancus uniquely developed by the polar climate physical and physiological mechanisms  
45 and characteristic different from the Rafaltic, Aquatic and eve the rest of Arctlectic indigenous groups  
46 that individually are exposed to different radiation levels and periods that caused those groups to develop  
47 different types of hair for different climates are described in more details in the *Eugenix® Indigenous  
48 Heritage - Classification of Sub Climatic Tribal Ethnicities, Eugenix® Indigenous Heritage - Short  
49 History of Natural Arctic Ethnicity, Eugenix® Indigenous Health - Indigenous Ethnicities and  
50 Outdigenous Conditions.*

51

52 Other types of unique symbiosed relationships between the Arcticus Blancus and the polar  
53 ecosystem is our indigenous polar culture based on the life that avoids strong and frequent radiation  
54 changes present in most of the planet that has caused our group according to our internal indigenous  
55 history to explore the Arctic and Antarctic hundreds of thousands of year ago and by permanently  
56 involved us in the diet composed polar fish species that made us think about the protection of polar  
57 ecosystem from the exploitation that has a negative effect on the sustainment of all polar species that are  
58 symbiosed only to own ecosystem.

59

60 Once the ice has broken in to the Arctic ocean and many seas the Arcticus Blancus has been  
61 involved in the sub-arctic forestry and farming until the 1000 AD when, Christians influence caused our  
62 group to loose land rights forcing migrations and disassociations until the establishment of the Arcticus  
63 Blancus company Eugenix P.S.A that revives our indigenous polar life and indigenous climate protective



64 programs. Main purpose of the farming and forestry occupations tried by the Arcticus Blancus was  
65 development of linen rope, linen nets, linen sails, linen clothing and small wood boats that were used by  
66 the Arcticus Blancus on the Baltic Sea to fish for herring and thing about the ice. Now we know that our  
67 small fishing villages in the shores of the Baltic Sea served us all the knowledge necessary to develop  
68 *Eugenix P.S.A. Ice Removal Program* that will rely on the use of *Purse Sein Nets* to remove big portion  
69 of 10,000,000 km<sup>3</sup> of ice economically, consecutively.

## LEGALITY

73 Eugenix P.S.A. legal actions intended to formalize the rights of the Arcticus Blancus indigenous  
74 polar persons in form of complete control over entire indigenous polar territorial resources equal to  
75 56,666,666 km<sup>2</sup> in total that consist of 28,333,333 km<sup>2</sup> of Arctic and 28,333,333 km<sup>2</sup> of Antarctic that  
76 allows the Arcticus Blancus company Eugenix P.S.A. to establish; Arcticus Blancus indigenous  
77 reservations on polar territories; Arcticus Blancus company Eugenix P.S.A. fair sale of the frozen water  
78 assets contained in the Antarctic region thru the *Eugenix P.S.A. Antarctic Ice Removal Program* that will  
79 allow Arcticus Blancus company Eugenix P.S.A. to finance the construction of *Eugenix P.S.A.*  
80 *Geomagnetic Dams* on designated region of the Arctic and Antarctic cleared of 10,000,000 km<sup>3</sup> of frozen  
81 ice are based on the rights of the indigenous and tribal persons contained in the United Nations  
82 conventions, declarations and resolutions.

83

84 United Nations provisions of law that benefit the Arcticus Blancus company Eugenix P.S.A.  
85 rights to advocate for the complete return of both polar regions to Arcticus Blancus legal representant  
86 Eugenix P.S.A. company in the amount of to 56,666,666 km<sup>2</sup> in total that consist of 28,333,333 km<sup>2</sup> of  
87 Arctic and 28,333,333 km<sup>2</sup> of Antarctic are contained in the *UN Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous*  
88 *Peoples (2007)*, *UN ILO Indigenous and Tribal Peoples Convention (1989)*, *UN Convention on the*  
89 *Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide (1946)*. The benefit of Arcticus Blancus control  
90 over the polar region will result in Eugenix P.S.A. climate repair programs and restoration of indigenous  
91 rights of other groups that lost the control over own climatic territories to states emerged to complete  
92 territorial control by the mechanisms of religious and physical occupation established against the will  
93 and needs of indigenous inhabitants.

95 The states that formed religious, territorial and racial doctrines against the Arcticus Blancus and  
96 other Arcletic, Rafaltic and Aquatic indigenous persons are not only the states of the United States of  
97 America, but states of the European Union, Russian Federation, Scandinavia, Greenland, Canada and all  
98 other states that have been forming civilizations from the beginning of the time based on religious,  
99 political, territorial and racial doctrines that had no self-containment and no out-respect to other  
100 indigenous persons and groups that resulted in today evident lack of strong understanding among the  
101 members of the United Nations and unliberated indigenous societies within individual member states.

### EUGENIX P.S.A.

104

105 Arcticus Blancus company Eugenix P.S.A is a self-funding indigenous simple shares corporation  
106 that is still unable to assist Arcticus Blancus indigenous persons in the relocation efforts to indigenous  
107 reservations since the reservations and budgets have not been yet provided by the states where Eugenix  
108 P.S.A. has legal rights to demand such. In addition some indigenous persons outside Eugenix P.S.A. legal  
109 reach might have to be involve in the repatriation, relocation, return to the indigenous or historically  
110 occupied territories based on the United Nations laws contained in the *UN ILO Indigenous and Tribal  
111 Peoples Convention (1989)* and others might have to be involve in the repatriation, relocation, return to the  
112 indigenous or historically occupied territories based on the *UN Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous  
113 Peoples (2007)* due various legal forms of protections established an ratified in the United Nations member  
114 states located on the Arcticus Blancus indigenous polar territory and historically occupied areas of the sub-  
115 polar territory.

116

117 Eugenix P.S.A. main priorities are intended to prevent the genocide of own group as provided by  
118 the *UN Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide (1946)* that will necessitate  
119 the involvement of many Arcticus Blancus indigenous markers such as Ethnic Hair Quantum and other  
120 ethnic criteria defined in the *Eugenix® Ethnic Hair Quantum - Climatic Work Ethnic Predisposition* that  
121 have been developed to protect the Arcticus Blancus indigenous persons sustainment from the threat  
122 various forms of genocide.

123

124 Eugenix P.S.A. attempts to communicate with the members of the United Nations that ratified the  
125 *UN ILO Indigenous and Tribal Peoples Convention (1989)* has not been successful regardless of the vast  
126 amount of electronic and paper correspondence sent to those member which makes the quick return,



127 relocation, repatriation of Arcticus Blancus indigenous persons more difficult than Eugenix P.S.A. has been  
128 for prepared.

129

130 Eugenix P.S.A. still hopes and plans for the successful organization of reservations for the  
131 indigenous persons and able financial resources based on the rights to such contained in the *UN Declaration*  
132 *on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples (2007)* in the Arcticus Blancus territories above 62.75° North, but also  
133 in the sub-polar territories once occupied by the Arcticus Blancus for example the shores of the Baltic sea.  
134 In the event of the successful organization of reservations and financial resources that can support  
135 indigenous persons relocation and reintroduction to indigenous economy based on the fishery, farming and  
136 forestry the number of spaces in the reservations will still depend on the amount of allocated territory and  
137 allocated financial resources from the states that honor the *UN Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous*  
138 *Peoples (2007)*. to the Arcticus Blancus indigenous reservations.

139

140 Arcticus Blancus as primary indigenous persons even in the sub-polar region of the Baltic Sea  
141 known as *tubylcy* which means “local people” that is derived from the Arcticus Blancus language phrase  
142 *Tu byl se ya !* that later enter the slavic language meaning *łowienie* that translates to the occupation that  
143 strictly involves fishing has rights to reservations in the subpolar region based on historic presence that is  
144 protected by the *UN Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples (2007)*. Arcticus Blancus has been  
145 also present in the sub-polar regions of North America, where it will try to reestablish its rights. It is  
146 Arcticus Blancus believe that the American Bison and European Bisons names derived from the time when  
147 Bisons and Arcticus Blancus traveled between the Russia and Canada thru once frozen passage and by  
148 acquired the name *Bison* which means *Bi-zoned (Two-zoned)* animal.

149

## 150 **RESERVATIONS ADMITTANCE PRIORITIES**

151

152 The rules of priority admittance set by the Arcticus Blancus Eugenix P.S.A. for all Arcticus  
153 Blancus indigenous and semi-indigenous persons due to the mentioned already in above sections a certain  
154 possibility of limited territorial and financial commitment from the United Nations members obligated to  
155 accommodate the rights and loses of the indigenous persons will vary for Arcticus Blancus indigenous  
156 persons based several factors.

157



158 **Factor 1** that allows the Arcticus Blancus indigenous persons to be admitted to the indigenous  
159 reservations is the Ethnic Hair Quantum that measures indigenous person association to the Arcticus  
160 Blancus based on number of ethnic hairs of natural white polar color that physically determines and  
161 enumerates persons natural indigenous association. The lower the number of ethnic hair quantum points  
162 the higher the priority for the admittance to the Arcticus Blancus indigenous reservations.

163  
164 **Factor 2** that allows the Arcticus Blancus indigenous persons to be admitted to the indigenous  
165 reservations is the Risk of Genocide that prioritizes indigenous persons admittance based on the life-  
166 threatening situations defined below:

- 167  
168 a. Sexual Exploitation.  
169 b. Medical Condition.  
170 c. Military Conflict.  
171 d. Natural Disaster.  
172 e. Wrong Climate.  
173 f. Wrong Community.

174  
175 **Factor 3** that allows the Arcticus Blancus indigenous persons to be admitted to the indigenous  
176 reservations is the Persons Age that prioritizes indigenous persons admittance based on the personal  
177 independence defined below:

- 178  
179 g. Newborn – 0 days to 1 month.  
180 h. Infant – 1 month to 1 year.  
181 i. Toddler – 1 year to 3 years.  
182 j. Preschool – 3 years to 6 years.  
183 k. School – 6 years to 12 years.  
184 l. Teen – 12 years to 18 years.  
185 m. Adult - Above the age of 18.

186  
187 **Factor 4** that allows the Arcticus Blancus indigenous persons to be admitted to the indigenous  
188 reservations is the Personal Commitment that prioritizes indigenous persons admittance based on the  
189 personal commitment to the defined below indigenous causes that require a personal commitment from



190 the indigenous persons to provide critical support skills for other indigenous persons that are being  
191 admitted to the Arcticus Blancus reservations not limited to the skills listed below:

  - 194 o. Indigenous Architecture and Engineering.
  - 195 p. Indigenous Education and Employment.
  - 196 q. Indigenous Fishing and Fish Processing.
  - 197 r. Indigenous Geese and Sheep Breeding.
  - 198 s. Indigenous Medicine and Healthcare.
  - 199 t. Indigenous Nursing and Childcare.
  - 200 u. Indigenous Forestry and Carpentry.
  - 201 v. Indigenous Textiles and Weaving.
  - 202 w. Indigenous Botany and Farming.
  - 203 x. Indigenous Sailing and Boating.
  - 204 y. Indigenous Culture and Values.
  - 205 z. Indigenous Diet and Nutrition.

207 **Factor 5** that allows the Arcticus Blancus indigenous persons to be admitted to the indigenous  
208 reservations is the Indigenous Martial Status that prioritizes indigenous persons admittance based on the  
209 personal indigenous marital status that applies to all indigenous persons that seek the admittance to the  
210 Arcticus Blancus reservations as defined in the First Priority of the *Eugenix® Ethnic Hair Quantum -*  
211 *Climatic Work Ethnic Predisposition* that specifies the rules of employment of the *Eugenix P.S.A.*  
212 *Antarctic Ice Removal program* and *Eugenix P.S.A. Geomagnetic Dams Construction program* for the  
213 Arcticus Blancus indigenous persons.

- 215 aa. Single, separated, divorced, widowed persons without underage children that understand and  
216 follow rules of mono-indigenous relationships that prohibit inter-indigenous intimate and  
217 sexual relationships between persons from different ethnic hair group as defined in the  
218 *Eugenix® Indigenous Heritage - Indigenous Climatic Procreation* who's all direct living  
219 relatives such as parents, grandparents and great-grandparents on the side of the father and  
220 mother family understand and follow rules of mono-indigenous relationships.

222 bb. Single, separated, divorced, widowed persons with underage children of same indigenous  
223 ethnic hair group as the legal guardian parent that understand and follow rules of mono-  
224 indigenous relationships that prohibit inter-indigenous intimate and sexual relationships  
225 between persons from different ethnic hair group as defined in the *Eugenix® Indigenous*  
226 *Heritage - Indigenous Climatic Procreation* who's all direct living relatives such as parents,  
227 grandparents and great-grandparents on the side of the father and mother family understand  
228 and follow rules of mono-indigenous relationships.

229  
230 cc. Dating, engaged, married persons with underage children of same indigenous ethnic hair  
231 group as the both legal guardian parents that understand and follow rules of mono-indigenous  
232 relationships that prohibit inter-indigenous intimate and sexual relationships between persons  
233 from different ethnic hair group as defined in the *Eugenix® Indigenous Heritage - Indigenous*  
234 *Climatic Procreation*. who's all direct living relatives such as parents, grandparents and great-  
235 grandparents on the side of the father and mother family understand and follow rules of mono-  
236 indigenous relationships.

## 237 238 DEFINITION OF ARCTICUS BLANCUS INDIGENOUS PERSON

239  
240 Arcticus Blancus indigenous person is defined as an individual who was born with visibly and  
241 naturally occurring white translucent and/or clear transparent polar hair on indigenous persons external  
242 surfaces of the skin. Arcticus Blancus distinctive indigenous polar climate hair should be naturally  
243 inherited from both parents thru mono-indigenous relationship also defined in the *Eugenix® Indigenous*  
244 *Heritage - Indigenous Climatic Procreation* that qualifies both the parents and their indigenous child to  
245 all Arcticus Blancus indigenous inclusions especially the Arcticus Blancus company Eugenix P.S.A.  
246 climate repair and indigenous rights programs of employment, management and other indigenous rights  
247 and benefits.

248  
249 Arcticus Blancus indigenous persons *Ethnic Hair Quantum* defines the persons indigenous  
250 phenotype, but the status of indigenous person's association to the Arcticus Blancus indigenous polar  
251 climate hair tribal group is defined also by other important rules stated in the fifth factor of *Reservations*  
252 *Admittance Priorities* quoted from *Eugenix® Ethnic Hair Quantum - Climatic Work Ethnic*  
253 *Predisposition* that pertain to status of relationships among other Arcticus Blancus indigenous persons all



254 direct living family members such as own parents, grandparents, great-grandparents that affect the  
255 sustainment of all members of the Arcticus Blancus persons in mono-indigenous relationships.

256  
257 The reason why mono-indigenous relationships are so important to the sustainment of the  
258 Arcticus Blancus is that the children born in multi-indigenous relationships (indigenous person + non-  
259 indigenous person) where first parent is the Arcticus Blancus indigenous persons born from Arcticus  
260 Blancus mono-indigenous parents (indigenous person + indigenous person) and second parent is a non-  
261 indigenous parent (non-indigenous + non-indigenous) statistically thru biological mechanisms add to the  
262 extinction of natural Arcticus Blancus polar climate hair ethnic physical characteristics that especially  
263 affect the male population of Arcticus Blancus with congenital disorders such as: *heterotrichosis*,  
264 *heterchromia*, *heterodermia* that increases the risk of more severe congenital conditions such as:  
265 *Epidermolysis Bullosa* and *Neurocutaneous Melanosis* as far as the Eugenix P.S.A. anthropological  
266 research shows.

#### 267 268 **DEFINITION OF ARCTICUS BLANCUS SEMI-INDIGENOUS PERSON**

269  
270 Arcticus Blancus semi-indigenous person is defined as an individual who was born with visibly  
271 and naturally occurring white translucent and/or clear transparent polar hair on indigenous persons  
272 external surfaces of the skin. Arcticus Blancus distinctive indigenous polar climate hair should be  
273 naturally inherited from both parents thru semi-indigenous relationship also defined in the *Eugenix®*  
274 *Indigenous Heritage - Indigenous Climatic Procreation* that qualifies both the parents and their  
275 indigenous child to all Arcticus Blancus indigenous inclusions especially the Arcticus Blancus company  
276 Eugenix P.S.A. climate repair and indigenous rights programs of employment, management and other  
277 indigenous rights and benefits.

278  
279 Similarly the Arcticus Blancus semi-indigenous persons *Ethnic Hair Quantum* also defines the  
280 persons indigenous phenotype, and similarly the status of semi-indigenous person's association to the  
281 Arcticus Blancus indigenous polar climate hair tribal group is also defined by other Arcticus Blancus  
282 indigenous rules stated in the fifth factor of *Reservations Admittance Priorities* quoted from *Eugenix®*  
283 *Ethnic Hair Quantum - Climatic Work Ethnic Predisposition* that pertain to status of relationships among  
284 other Arcticus Blancus indigenous persons all direct living family members such as own parents,



285 grandparents, great-grandparents that affect the sustainment of all members of the Arcticus Blancus  
286 persons in mono-indigenous relationships.

287

## 288 ARCTICUS BLANCUS REEMERGED INDIGENOUS PERSONS

289

290 Eugenix P.S.A. will qualify for the admittance to the Arcticus Blancus Reservations and  
291 associated Eugenix P.S.A. programs and benefits all Arcticus Blancus indigenous persons that inherited  
292 hidden indigenous polar climate hair hidden in parents from of another Arctic or Co-Arctic ethnic hair  
293 color as defined in the *Eugenix® Ethnic Hair Quantum - Climatic Hair Ethnic Classification*, thru a  
294 biological-genetic-processes that can allow for the Arcticus Blancus hidden or low amounted polar ethnic  
295 hair to reemerge and be visibly present again. Arcticus Blancus natural polar climate hair characteristics  
296 in persons conceived from parents of same darker color hair can reemerge if parents of such persons had  
297 ancestors that had relationships with lighter hair persons. Statistics of healthy reemergence of hidden  
298 Arcticus Blancus ethnic physical characteristics are very low.

299

300 Arcticus Blancus indigenous persons in such situation must be aware that Arcticus Blancus  
301 natural polar climate hair physical characteristic regained in such way might be multi-phenotypical  
302 (hetero-phenotypical – means the physical characteristic might change) in first generation with means  
303 that with the person age they might slowly become hidden again that will affect such person Ethnic Hair  
304 Quantum that qualifies such person for the admittance to the reservations. Eugenix P.S.A. Advise to such  
305 persons not to give up the hopes and dreams of becoming admitted to the Arcticus Blancus reservations  
306 and to such persons correct reproductive association defined in the *Eugenix® Indigenous Heritage -*  
307 *Indigenous Climatic Procreation* that allows to such person next generation children to have increased  
308 time of life of Arcticus Blancus indigenous characteristic and Ethnic Hair Quantum that qualifies persons  
309 next generation children for the Arcticus Blancus indigenous reservations and associated benefits and  
310 programs. Persons that regained portion of Arcticus Blancus phenotype from non Arcticus Blancus  
311 mono-indigenous or non Arcticus Blancus semi-indigenous relationships might qualify for temporary  
312 status that qualifies them for temporary benefits to encourage their indigenous path of life.

## 314 ADMITTANCE RULES CHANGES

315



316 Eugenix P.S.A. has not defined any exceptions for indigenous and semi-indigenous persons that  
317 do not meet the rule criteria's defined by other Arcticus Blancus indigenous rules stated in the fifth factor  
318 of *Reservations Admittance Priorities* quoted from *Eugenix® Ethnic Hair Quantum - Climatic Work*  
319 *Ethnic Predisposition* that pertain to status of relationships among other Arcticus Blancus indigenous  
320 persons all direct living family members such as own parents, grandparents, great-grandparents that affect  
321 the sustainment of all members of the Arcticus Blancus persons in mono-indigenous relationships.

322  
323 Eugenix P.S.A., however will accept written complaints and propositions from indigenous and  
324 semi-indigenous persons that provide solutions and explain all inabilities of such individual and their  
325 families that prevent indigenous and semi-indigenous applicants from meeting all necessary indigenous  
326 criteria policies that prevent them and their indigenous and semi-indigenous parents from being qualified  
327 for the acceptance to the Arcticus Blancus indigenous polar climate hair tribal group and Eugenix P.S.A.  
328 simple shares corporation established by Arcticus Blancus indigenous polar climate hair tribe dedicated  
329 to the indigenous climate repair and indigenous rights programs.

### 330 331 **REPATRIATION OF NATIONAL OR FOREGIN STATE UNDERGAE ORPHANS**

332  
333 Eugenix P.S.A. will add all possible and necessary efforts to allow repatriations of all Arcticus  
334 Blancus indigenous orphans – persons below 18 years that have physical characteristics of Arcticus Blancus  
335 indigenous polar climate hair tribal persons as defined in this document that will be given adequate  
336 association of favorable priority factors for such persons as defined in this document in coordination with  
337 indigenous orphan person residence state legal guardians and in accordance with the laws of indigenous  
338 orphan person state of residence that include all United Nations laws ratified by the state of legal residence  
339 indigenous orphan persons.

### 340 341 **ARCTICUS BLANCUS INDIGENOUS RESERVATIONS OUTSIDE OF POLAR** 342 **TERRITORIES AND FOREIGN RESERVATIONS IN THE POLAR TERRITORIES**

343  
344 Eugenix P.S.A. as the Arcticus Blancus indigenous group company dedicated to the repair of the  
345 climate repair and return of the indigenous rights necessary to secure a healthy future for Arcticus  
346 Blancus persons is also aware of the health needs of other persons around the world that could benefit  
347 from Arcticus Blancus polar climate to cope and heal a variety of conditions that are less serious to



348 persons health in polar conditions. Similarly, Arcticus Blancus and Eugenix P.S.A. can benefit from  
349 private indigenous reservations in territories outside of polar areas for the purposes of the health and  
350 healing, climate monitoring, biodiversity education and shareholders relations.

351

352 Eugenix P.S.A. to allow mutual temporary provisions that permit the outside climate indigenous  
353 groups to establish temporary restrictive purpose reservations in the Arcticus Blancus polar climate  
354 territory has prepare two separate publications; *Eugenix® Indigenous Territories - Permanent Protection*  
355 *Areas* that defines the amount of territory that can be leased out to outside indigenous groups in the polar  
356 areas which is the same amount of territory that Arcticus Blancus is willing to leased out from the outside  
357 indigenous groups climate for very strict limited purposes that are defined in the *Eugenix® Indigenous*  
358 *Reservations - Admittance Guidelines* that will apply also to all outside groups that are planning to  
359 benefit from the Arcticus Blancus polar territory for humane causes such as; climate related activities,  
360 biodiversity research, healthy habitation and healing programs for persons affected by conditions such as  
361 albinism as defined in the *Eugenix® Indigenous Health - Ethnicities and Outdigenous Conditions*.
